Per our discussions regarding Phase 1 Services, we are providing revised fee information for the project. In order to accommodate in-person participation of Bull Stockwell Allen Architects during Phase 1, we have adjusted the distribution of fee among our team members. The total fee for each phase remains as previously presented.

Given the wide range of potential outcomes for the project—ranging from renovation, additions, and/or demolition-new construction—we have based our fee proposal on a hybrid option which assumes the existing chalet would be renovated with an addition as well. We anticipate the Phase I services will clarify the scope of work for the project. We also anticipate the fees and schedule will need to be confirmed as we near the completion of the Phase I services. If the scope of work or schedule varies from the assumptions of this proposal, we will provide an updated proposal for that scope of work.
