

The purpose of this modification/amendment is to modify ARTICLE V – RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES and ARTICLE VIII – AWARD AND PAYMENT. Additional funding will be added for trail design projects.

MODIFICATION

- 1. ARTICLE V RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES. The following is added:
 - A. The Recipient Agrees to:
 - 5. Place-based Experiential Programming: Develop plans for various education/outreach events for the Morgan Park community members for primarily 2024-2026. The types of activities have been identified in City plans.
 - 6. Complete final design and implementation drawings for trailheads at Blackmer Park and Munger Landing to 100% final design and engineers cost estimate.
 - 7. Complete final designs and engineer cost estimates for Trail Segments 0-2.
- 2. ARTICLE VIII AWARD AND PAYMENT. The following is added: Additional Federal funding in and amount not to exceed \$140,000 will be added to this agreement in accordance with the Federally approved budget. The approved budget detail is incorporated herein. Any award beyond the current fiscal year is subject to availability of funds. Acceptance of a Federal financial assistance award from the Department of the Interior carries with it the responsibility to be aware of, and comply with, the terms and conditions within this award document. Acceptance is defined as the start of work, drawing down funds, or accepting the award via electronic means.
- 3. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.



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
