

DULUTH PARKING COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2017-18

July 21, 2017

To recommend new Duluth East High School Residential Permit Parking Zone boundaries.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to reduce the overall size of the Duluth East High School Residential Permit Parking zone by approximately 22 blocks on the north half of the existing zone and approximately two blocks on the southeast corner of the zone, eliminating the following areas:


- Dodge Street, Jay Street, Pitt Street, Rockview Court, Cooke Street, Gladstone Street east of 40th Avenue East and west of Northland Avenue, 40th Avenue East north of Gladstone Street, 41st Avenue East north of McColloch Street, 43rd Avenue East north of Robinson Street, 44th Avenue East north of Robinson Street, and Gilliat Street, Luverne Street, Lombard Street, and London Road east of 43rd Avenue East.

Cambridge Street, from Superior Street to London Road, would be added to the zone.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to implement a no parking zone on a portion of West Austin Street between Colman Avenue and Elysian Avenue, at the crest of a hill and along a particularly narrow portion of road.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:


To add five single-space meters to the 200 block of West Superior Street.


IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to add five single-space parking meters to a portion of the 200 block of West Superior Street.

This action serves to align the referenced area's parking configuration with that of the adjacent areas. The area had previously been a bus stop that is no longer used. The meters will feature the same rates and time limits as those adjacent.

To reconfigure parking related to the conversion of certain downtown avenues to two-way traffic.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to approve the following changes on 3rd Street and 1st Street in downtown Duluth:

1. Relocation of two bus stops on 3rd Street
2. Extension of parking setbacks on 1st Avenue West, 2nd Avenue West, and 3rd Avenue West at the 3rd Street intersections to improve sightlines
3. Relocation of a loading zone on 1st Street near 2nd Avenue West, to eliminate one single-meter space, to improve sightlines


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This action serves to provide improved bus stop locations and to enhance safety for motorists and pedestrians following the change to two-way from one-way traffic on the referenced avenues.

To convert a loading zone on East 2nd Street to four-hour time limit parking.


IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to convert a loading zone on the south side of the 300 block of East 2nd Street to four-hour time limit parking.

This action serves to better address the current parking needs of the referenced area. The adjacent business that previously used the loading zone no longer exists, and the four-hour time limit aligns the zone with the configuration of the adjacent areas.

To extend setbacks from a driveway on 29th Avenue West.


