PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: None

BACKGROUND: The City Purchasing Division issued an agreement to LHB to complete the Aerial Lift Bridge (ALB) routine and complex inspection. Complex bridge inspections are required by the FHWA on three bridges in the State of Minnesota, with the ALB being one of them. As part of this complex bridge inspection, LHB is bringing in Hardesty and Hanover (H&H), a national expert in movable bridges as a subconsultant to assist with the detailed electrical and mechanical inspection. H&H has worked with LHB on past ALB rehabilitation projects.

BUDGET/FISCAL: This is a budgeted expense using a combination of operations and street maintenance levy funding (Fund 290).

OPTIONS: This is a necessary expense to do a federally required complex inspection of the movable bridge. LHB and H&H have the expertise and working knowledge of the ALB to perform this inspection.
