

MOTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 17-0652

BY COUNCILOR HOBBS AND HANSEN:

We move to amend Resolution 17-0652 as follows:

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 275.065, the city council adopts the following proposed tax levy:

Section 1. The sum to be raised by taxation for the year 2018 for general operations is hereby determined to be the sum of ~~\$27,598,792~~ 27,776,292 which sum is levied against the taxable property of the city of Duluth and appropriated to the various accounts of the city, as set forth in the following sections, viz:

Section 2. There will be levied for the support of the general fund the sum of ~~\$15,928,600~~ 16,106,100.

Section 3. There will be levied for the support of the street lighting fund the amount of \$757,592.

Section 4. For the payment of debt, there will be levied for the general obligation debt fund the sum of \$6,832,600.

Section 5. That pursuant to Laws of Minnesota 1971, Chapter 824, to pay for the portion of the cost of local improvements which will not sustain a special assessment, there will be levied for the permanent improvement fund the sum of \$280,000.

Section 6. There will be levied for the support of the street maintenance utility fund the amount of \$3,800,000

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The purpose of this motion to amend Resolution 17-0652 is to increase the maximum property tax levy for 2018 by \$177,500 to fund the city's public safety operations. The amendment would represent a 0.70% additional levy increase.
