RESOLUTION 2016-7

March 4, 2016

To reconfigure the parking configuration of the 200 block of West Michigan Street.


IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to reconfigure parking on the 200 block of West Michigan Street to include a 45-foot loading zone, a ten-minute drop-off zone, and six single-space 80-minute meters on the north side of the street. The loading zone and drop-off zone will be effective Monday through Sunday. Parking will be prohibited on the north side of Michigan Street from 3rd Avenue West to the beginning of the loading zone. Additionally, two single space meters on the south side of the street will be converted to police-only parking spaces.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This action serves to reconfigure parking in the referenced area to best suit the current needs of stakeholders. The recent construction of the adjacent Duluth Transportation Center and changes in the area businesses had resulted in an outdated and impractical parking configuration.


To relocate and convert a loading zone on East 9th Street to a drop-off zone.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to relocate the loading zone between 1220 and 1224 East 9th Street six feet eastward and to redesignate it as a drop-off zone Monday through Sunday.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This action serves to relocate the referenced parking zone slightly to the east to better line up with the current and future sidewalk access configuration and to redesignate the zone as a drop-off zone to better suit the needs of the adjacent businesses.


To relocate a drop-off zone on East 9th Street.


To prohibit parking on a portion of East 9th Street.

This action serves to address concerns regarding sightlines for drivers on East 9th Street and 11th Avenue East as they approach each other. The aforementioned change will increase visibility at the intersection.

*To establish a temporary limit on the number of monthly contract parkers at the ramp
to be opened at 410 West First Street*

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to establish a limit of 460 monthly contract parkers who may be enrolled upon the opening of the 410 West First Street parking ramp, which limit shall remain in place for three months after the facility's opening, after which point future limits on the number of monthly contract parkers shall be established administratively by city staff.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This action serves to set an initial limit on contract parking in the 410 West First Street parking ramp that will accommodate the demand for both monthly contract and transient parking in the facility while allowing for an orderly enrollment of contract parkers.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to implement a transient parking rate of \$2.00 (including tax) per hour, or fraction thereof, with a calendar day maximum of \$10.00 (including tax) on weekdays, a flat calendar day rate of \$3.00 (including tax) on Saturdays, a flat calendar day rate of \$3.00 (including tax) on Sundays, and a flat evening rate of \$3.00 (including tax) for vehicles arriving after 3:59 p.m. on weekdays and leaving by 6:00 a.m. the following morning—all to be available on a first-come, first-served basis to users of the public parking ramp to be opened at 410 West First Street.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This action serves to provide transient parking options for users of the public parking ramp to be opened at 410 West First Street.
