Re: State Disaster Shoreline Rehab. Areas – Amendment No. 4 AMI Project # 231016

Ms. MacManus,

The following Amendment Request has been prepared for the City of Duluth State Disaster project. AMI Consulting Engineers (AMI) currently has a Contract to provide design, permitting, bidding services, and 25% construction administration services for this project. Due to the increase in construction time for Congdon Blvd. Sites A-D, services outside of the initial contract were required.

Item No. 1 - Congdon Blvd: Sites A-D Additional Construction Administration Services

Congdon Boulevard construction began November 1, 2023, and was expected to last 4 weeks (1 week per site). During construction additional work was added to project sites B&D, this work included:

- addition of two hammerhead turnarounds on Site B
- additional erosion control blanket installation on Site D
- additional riprap installation and oversight on Site B
- DNR permitting coordination for Site B riprap
- additional contractor coordination, pay app reviews, change orders, etc.

The **construction lasted a total of 8 weeks** (ended on December 29th, 2023) on site. AMI is requesting an amendment to cover the additional hours AMI spent performing construction administration duties beyond the 4 weeks provided. The added hours equate to an additional: 4 weeks of onsite inspections, construction meetings, and change order/pay app coordination (4 weeks out of 8 weeks) or \$4,500.00. As change orders are still being processed for this work, AMI estimates an additional \$500.00 will be needed for the remaining project closeout items. Note: AMI is not charging for the total additional weeks of construction, but only for the time AMI was actively performing the construction administration duties.

Summary

<u>AMI is requesting an increase in the contract amount by \$5,000.00 to cover the additional</u> <u>construction administration services for this project including the remaining project closeout</u> <u>services. This change would increase the contract amount from \$201,450.00 to \$206,450.00.</u> We sincerely appreciate the continued opportunities to work with the City of Duluth on these projects.
