PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

July 15, 2024: Council approved entering into a Project Partnership Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

February 13, 2023: Council approved an agreement with the engineering consultant for design services.

September 26, 2022: Council approved entering into a grant agreement with the Great Lakes Commission.

May 9, 2022: Council approved applying for a grant agreement with the Great Lakes Commission.

BACKGROUND: This resolution will authorize City Officials to enter into a contract for the Keene Creek Resiliency-Irving Park Biofiltration Basin project with Veit & Company, Inc. in the amount of \$425,393.00. Veit & Company, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder of the five companies that responded. The project will divert and treat stormwater runoff from the storm sewer in 57th Ave, draining over 15 acres of the surrounding neighborhood, before it is discharged to Keene Creek. Keene Creek is impaired by e. coli and the stormwater basin is designed to filter the stormwater to remove e. coli. The basin will also remove sediment, trash, and other pollutants, as well as help the City comply with state MS4 stormwater discharge requirements.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: The working fund of this project is Stormwater Utility Fund (535), and Federal Grant funds. This project was budgeted for FY2025.

OPTIONS: Approve or delay capital improvements.
