# PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES – AMENDMENT 01 1<sup>ST</sup> AVENUE EAST (SUPERIOR ST TO 3<sup>RD</sup> ST) RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

In accordance with our ongoing discussions and final design work on the project we have prepared the following summary of additional services and costs related to the contract. This amendment would cover additional costs incurred during design and construction as well as provide a working budget to complete construction in the spring/summer of 2024. Work is summarized as follows:

#### **Scope of Additional Services**

#### **Geotechnical Investigation**

Additional geotechnical investigation, performed by AET, was required to provide rock probe borings for the hot water and steam line services. This analysis will be summarized in the geotechnical report.

Additional geotechnical investigation, performed by Braun Intertec, was required to inform the additional structural engineering work needed to complete the project. The findings and recommendations will be summarized in a geotechnical evaluation report.

#### **Structural Engineering Design Services**

Additional structural engineering services needed to complete the project. The original structural scope included evaluation of existing vaults only. During design and following structural evaluation, it was determined that the retaining wall just south of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street would need to be replaced with the project as well as several vault lids. The additional structural scope includes design of the retaining wall and vault lids that needed to be replaced within the road corridor.

## **Street Lighting and Electrical Construction Services**

Additional electrical construction support services for the lighting, traffic signal and electrical work. This includes review of shop drawings related to electrical work and commissioning of the signal and lighting systems. This work is performed by SRF. SRF assumed the Street Lighting design task in full, as stated in the Prime Agreement, therefore the fees associated with the street lighting design task will be transferred to SRF.

#### **Construction Material Testing**

Material testing services during construction, performed by Braun Intertec. This includes a working budget to complete construction in the spring/summer of 2024.

### **Reduction in Fee for Evergreen Energy**

Following conversations with Evergreen Energy it was determined the budget originally scoped was more than necessary to complete the work. This amendment includes reducing the Evergreen budget and reallocating to help cover other additional services.

#### **Expenses**

Due to the increased duration of construction, additional expenses were incurred. These expenses included survey equipment and construction inspector vehicle.

#### **Fees**

The total amount of the additional services included in Amendment 01 is \$67,310, divided as follows:
