UTILITY EASEMENT RESTORATION AGREEMENT

This UTILITY EASEMENT RESOTRATION AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is made by and between RENOVO CAPITAL, LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company ("Grantor") and the CITY OF DULUTH, a municipal corporation and political subdivision created and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota (the "City").

RECITALS

A. Grantor owns real property in St. Louis County, Minnesota subject to a utility easement accepted by the City, which easement was recorded in the Office of the St. Louis County Recorder on April 25, 2023 as Document No. 01465465 (the "Utility Easement"), subject to that certain vacation resolution by the Duluth City Council, which resolution was recorded in the Office of the St. Louis County Recorder on August 15, 2023 as Document No. 01471975 (the "Vacation Resolution").

B. The utility easement area is legally described as follows (the "Easement Area"):

Over, under, and across the Northwesterly 20 feet of Lots 10 through 26, Block 1, LONDON EAST, according to the plat on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder, St. Louis County, Minnesota, EXCEPT all that part of the Northwesterly 3 feet of Lots 10 through 26, Block 1, LONDON EAST.

C. As a condition of the Utility Easement, the City requires that Grantor enter into this Agreement regarding restoration of the Easement Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, Grantor and the City agree as follows:

1. That Grantor shall be responsible, at its sole cost, for restoration and repair of any damage to the surface and to any private improvements located within the Easement Area as a

result of the City's exercise of its easement rights within the Easement Area, including but not limited to accessing, operating, maintaining, repairing, or replacing utilities.

2. That this Agreement shall extend to and bind the heirs, successors and assigns of Grantor and the City and shall run with the land.

3. That this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Minnesota, and all terms, conditions, and covenants herein shall be interpreted in accordance therewith.

4. That Grantor represents to the City that the individual(s) executing this document on behalf of Grantor have the requisite authority to execute this document, and to bind Grantor thereto.
