SUBJECT: Municipal State Aid Revocation & Designations

The following Municipal State Aid Street revocations will be approved when the City Council resolution has been received. (no paybacks)

- Part of MSAS 129: 1st Street- 14th Avenue E to 24th Avenue E (0.88 miles / one-way)
- Part of MSAS 130: 2nd Street- 21st Avenue E to 24th Avenue E (0.26 miles / one-way)
- Part of MSAS 190: Waseca Industrial Road- Raleigh Street to S. 59th Avenue W (0.49 non-existing miles)

The following Municipal State Aid Street designations will be approved when the City Council resolution has been received.

- Extension of MSAS 109: Superior Street- 22nd Avenue W to 19th Avenue W (0.29 miles)
- Extension of MSAS 133: 36th Avenue E- London Road (TH61) to Superior Street (0.28 miles)
- Extension of MSAS 134: 9th Street- Mesaba Avenue (TH194) to 1st Avenue E (0.01 miles)
- Extension of MSAS 141: 1st Avenue E- 7th Street to 9th Street (0.14 miles)
- MSAS 213: 4th Avenue E- Superior Street to 4th Street (0.28 miles)
- MSAS 214: Eklund Avenue- Maple Grove Road to Swan Lake Road (0.54 miles)

(For system continuity: we could "re-number" a portion of existing MSAS 144 on the upcoming Commissioner's Order: for 4th Avenue E: from 4th Street to 7th Street. Changing this to MSAS 213 would give all of 4th Avenue E the same MSAS#)

A Commissioner's Order will follow.
