PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE ENTITLED COURT:

Your Petitioner, the CITY OF DULUTH, by Albert R. Scanlon, Assistant City Attorney of said City, respectfully represents and shows to the Court:

- 1. That there is hereto attached original deed dated May 27, 1943, from the State of Minnesota, by its Commissioner of Taxation, to the City of Duluth whereby the State of Minnesota conveyed to said City of Duluth certain tax forfeited lands, pursuant to Laws 1941, Chapter 511.
- 2. That among the lots described in said deed under the designation "TRACT No. 2" are lots 146 to 164, both inclusive; lots 170 to 174, both inclusive; lots 178 to 190, both inclusive; lots 262 to 290, both inclusive; lots 298 to 320, both inclusive; and lots 346 to 356, both inclusive, all in Lake Avenue, Plat of Lower Duluth, situated in St. Louis County, Minnesota.
- J. That at the time application was made by said City of Duluth to the Commissioner of Taxation of the State of Minnesota, through the County Board of Commissioners for St. Louis County in Minnesota, which application was approved by said Board, it was the intent of the City to acquire from the State of Minnesota only the even numbered of those lots herein described, all of which even-numbered lots either border on Lake Superior or are immediately adjacent thereto.
- numbered lots are registered lands:

Lots 147, 149, 179, 265, 271, 273, 275, 281, 301, 303, 305, 307, 309, 311, 353 and 355; that it was not intended by said City of Duluth to acquire the lots

in this paragraph described, some or all of which may have been

forfeited to the State of Minnesota for nonpayment of taxes, and therefore your Petitioner does not desire to have said deed registered against Certificates of Title to any of the lots in this paragraph described.

- 5. That your Petitioner believes it to be expedient and proper to ask of this Court the relief hereinafter prayed for rather than to engage in correspondence with the Commissioner of Taxation for the State of Minnesota for the purpose of acquiring from the State of Minnesota a corrective deed omitting therefrom of the lands described in said "TRACT No. 2" of said deed the odd-numbered lots described therein.
- 6. That by registering said deed against Certificates of Title in the office of the Registrar of Titles for St. Louis County, Minnesota, to those even-numbered lots described in said "TRACT No. 2" of said deed, the title to the registered odd-numbered lots described in said "TRACT No. 2" of said deed will not be affected.
- 7. That certain other lands described in said deed are registered lands, and as to such lands it is desired that said deed be registered.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner prays for an order of this Court referring this Petition to the Examiner of Titles in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota, to investigate the truth of the allegations set forth in this Petition and to make his report to the Court thereon, and thereafter for an order of this Court authorizing and directing the Registrar of Titles in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota, to register said deed only as to the even-numbered lots which are registered and described in said "TRACT No. 2" of said deed, and in addition thereto to register said deed as to all lands described in said deed as "TRACT No. 1" and "TRACT No. 3" which may be registered lands.

THIS INDENTURE, made this 27th day of May 1943, between the State of Linnesota, as party of the first part, and The City of Duluth, a municipal corporation, of St. Louis County, Minnesota, as party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the land hereinafter described was duly forfeited to the State of Minnesota for the nonpayment of taxes, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Laws 1941, Chapter 511, the party of the second part has applied to the Commissioner of Taxation for the conveyance of lands hereinafter described to be used by it exclusively for public park purposes as to Tract No.1, and for public park, boulevard and municipal forest purposes as to Tracts Nos.2 and 3, , and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of ST. LOUIS, State of Minnesota, has recommended to the Commissioner of Taxation by resolution adopted on the 11th day of January 1943, that such conveyance be made,
