The parties have now agreed upon the new memorandum of understanding and related infrastructure funding agreement which results in modifications to the costs which will be incurred for resource room and reception area personnel costs at the Duluth CareerForce center.

### 2. 🛛 Amend Duties and Cost

- a. Describe the amendment: The vendor's duties shall remain the same. This amendment extends the expiration date of the original joint powers agreement and modifies the costs based on the terms agreed upon by City of Duluth and Employment Economic Development Vocational Rehabilitation Services (DEED-VRS) as outlined in the new memorandum of understanding, infrastructure funding agreement, and agreement on additional costs.
- b. If cost is amended, insert the amount of the original contract AND amount of each amendment below:

Under the original joint powers agreement, DEED-VRS agreed to pay the City of Duluth \$52.36 per hour for 9.96 hours of weekly reception services, 2.09 hours of weekly career lab services, and also agreed to pay \$5.23 per hour for 12.05 hours of weekly site management services. The total weekly cost for all services under the old agreement was \$693.96.

Under this amendment, DEED-VRS agrees to pay the City of Duluth \$32 per hour for 15.7 hours of weekly reception services and 11.2 hours of weekly career lab services. The total weekly cost under the new agreement is \$860.80.

This amendment is by and between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of Employment and Economic Development ("State" or "DEED") and City of Duluth whose designated business address is 402 W. 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Duluth, MN 55802 ("Governmental Unit"). State and Contractor may be referred to jointly as "Parties."

# Recitals

- 1. The State has a contract with the Contractor identified as SWIFT contract number 238676 ("Original Contract") to provide shared costs at the Duluth CareerForce center in Duluth, Minnesota.
- The Original Contract is being amended to modify the number of hours and hourly pay rate that DEED Vocational Rehabilitation Services ("VRS") shall pay to the Governmental Unit for the shared costs in accordance with 20 CFR 678.760.
- 3. The State and the Governmental Unit are willing to amend the Original Contract as stated below.

## **Contract Amendment**

In this Amendment, changes to pre-existing Contract language will use strike through for deletions and <u>underlining</u> for insertions.

**REVISION 1.** Clause 1 Term of Agreement, subclause 1.2 "Expiration Date" is amended as follows:

1.2 Expiration date: June 30, 2024, December 31, 2024, or until all obligations have been satisfactorily fulfilled, whichever occurs first.

**REVISION 2.** Clause 3 "**Payment**" is amended as follows:

The State will pay the Governmental Unit as outlined below effective as of April 22, 2024:

As a result of the agreement between DEED-VRS and Governmental Unit via the memorandum of understanding for the local workforce development area, the Parties agreed that DEED-VRS share of shared costs at the Duluth CareerForce location would be 36.7% of dedicated space. This resulted in an allocation of 15.7 hours of weekly reception time for DEED-VRS. The DEED-VRS share of dedicated space for the career lab is 37.36%, which results in an allocation of 11.2 hours per week for DEED-VRS.

The Governmental unit will invoice the State on a monthly basis. The monthly invoices should be sent to deed.adminv@state.mn.us and the State will pay for services upon completion and acceptance of the same.

The total obligation of the state under this Agreement will not exceed \$18,042.96 \$49,376.08.

The Original Contract and any previous amendments are incorporated into this agreement by reference. Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of the original contract and all previous amendments remain in full force and effect.
