EXHIBIT 1

PEDESTRIAN EASEMENT AGREEMENT

This Pedestrian Easement Agreement (this "Agreement") is made by and between JANET E. BLATNIK, a single person ("Blatnik") and the City of Duluth, a municipal corporation created and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota (the "City") for the benefit of the public as set forth herein.

RECITALS

- A. Blatnik owns the real property in St. Louis County, Minnesota legally described as follows (the "Property"):
 - The Easterly 16.00 feet of Lot 1, Block 4 and the vacated 20.00 foot wide alley lying between Block 3 and Block 4, LAKESIDE GARDENS, St. Louis County, Minnesota.
- B. Blatnik has agreed to grant a pedestrian easement over a portion of the Property and the City wishes to accept such pedestrian easement for the benefit of the public.
- C. The pedestrian easement area (the "Easement Area") is depicted on the attached Exhibit A and legally described on the attached Exhibit B.
- NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, including the City's vacation of an alley easement, Blatnik grants to the City, in trust for the benefit of the public, a perpetual easement for the construction, maintenance, inspection, operation, protection, repair, replacement, and/or removal of a pedestrian walking path within the Easement Area.

Blatnik reserves the right to use the Easement Area for purposes that will not interfere with the City's full enjoyment of the rights granted in this Agreement; provided Blatnik shall not erect or construct any buildings or other structures in the Easement Area. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Minnesota, and all terms, conditions, and covenants herein shall be interpreted in accordance therewith.


