PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

July 15, 2024: Council approved the designation of W. Skyline Parkway as one-way between Hank Jensen Drive and the Twin Ponds.

BACKGROUND: This resolution will authorize City Officials to enter into a Roadway Exchange Agreement with St. Louis County. Over the last year both the city and county have discussed how we can improve efficiencies for both agencies related to ownership and maintenance of the street network. An agreement was reached and consists of roads that improve efficiency for maintenance operations for both entities and are more intuitive for the general public. In addition, we are removing the segment of W. Skyline Parkway from the Municipal State Aid System and adding Hank Jensen Drive. Revoking and designating Municipal State Aid segments requires City Council approval.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: This should increase efficiencies for the Street Maintenance Division.

OPTIONS: Approve or deny the segment revisions.
