We move to amend Ordinance 16-030 as follows:

Section 1. That Section 50-15.2 of the Duluth City Code, 1959, as amended, be amended as follows:

50-1.1 Mixed Use-Neighborhood (MU-N).

A. Purpose.

MU-N The district is established to accommodate a mix of neighborhood-scale, neighbor-hood serving nonresidential uses and a range of residential uses located in close proximity. This district accommodates both horizontal (uses located in separate structures) and vertical (uses located in the same building) types of mixed use. Non-residential uses may include smallscale retail, service and professional offices that provide goods and services to the residents of the surrounding neighborhood, as shown in Table 50-19.8;
