Timing changes have been made for the Duluth Transportation Center to improve

schedule adherence and transfer connections.

Fare Increase:

None

Major Capital work:

Duluth Transportation Center – coming to completion in the last half of 2016. There are 6 diesel buses being delivered in the later part of the year and 6 all electric buses in the late in 2017. Three STRIDE vehicles will be replaced and ten large buses will be ordered for delivery in 2018.

Projects include: Truck with Plow (\$40,000), Replacement gas fueling station (\$20,000),

Updated Electrical network and generator (\$220,000), Remaining Door Replacements w/electronic locks (\$45,000), Hybrid Batteries (\$65,000).

Replacement Air unit for computer server room (\$10,000)

Operating Facility Roof Part 1, PE and Phase 1 work. Addition signals will

be upgraded at five intersections.

Lastly the DTA will be allocating funding to the Downtown Streetscape project scheduled to start in 2017 or 2018.

Funding:

MAP -21- and beyond - New Federal Transportation Bill

Most of the discretionary and/or earmark money have been moved into the formula programs. This is not positive for Duluth as the major part of the money is allocated based on Population and unfortunately population density (98% of the funds). A portion (1%) of the money is allocated based on performance indicators and the DTA

does well there. This part will increase in 2019.
