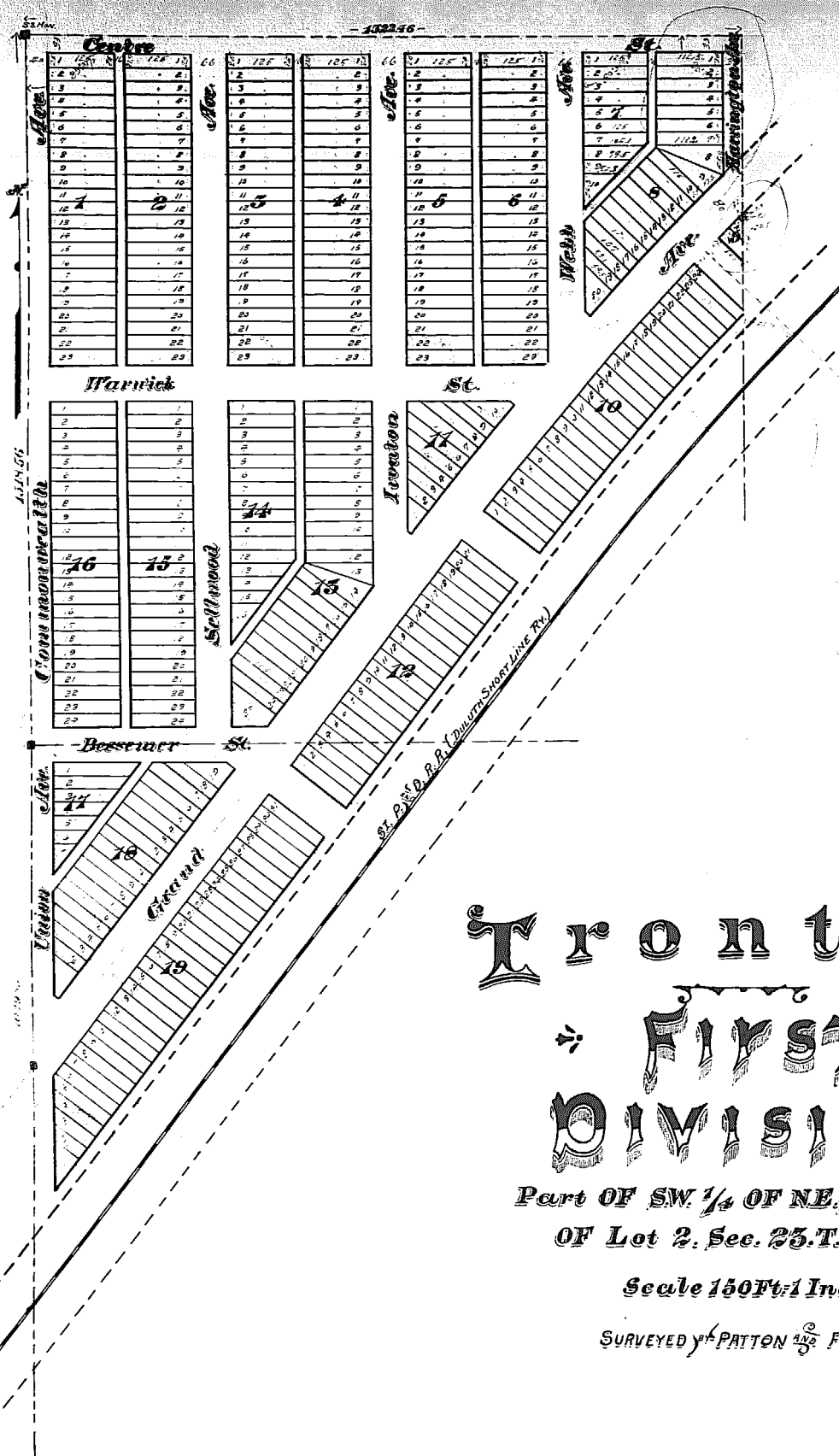

I know all men by their presents, that the St. Louis Bay Land Co. a corporation created under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Minnesota of Winnebago in the County of St. Louis, make aforesaid being the proprietor of the following described real estate to wit: that part of the south west one quarter (SW 1/4) of the north east one quarter (NE 1/4) and part of lot two (2) section twenty three (23) township forty nine (49) north Range fifteen (15) west of the fourth Principal Meridian according to the Government survey thereof which lies north westerly of the right of way of the St. Paul and Winnebago Railroad (Winnebago Short Line Railway) and being desirous of the platting the same into town lots have caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat thereof made in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided to be known as "Frontier First Division" and hereby dedicate to public use the streets avenues and alleys therein delineated. 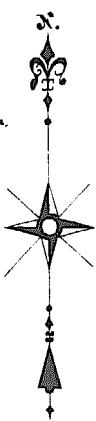
