4. Grant applicants must be a current member of the Minnesota Recreation & Park Foundation. If you are not a current member, please go online to <a href="www.mrpa.org">www.mrpa.org</a> to register.
5. Funds will be given on a reimbursement basis. Receipts or invoices need to be sent to the Foundation for expenses incurred up to the allocated amount. These must be submitted before December 1, 2019 and can be submitted to Lisa Abernathy. Grant checks then must be deposited before Dec. 31, 2019 to stay within the year the grant was issued.
6. By signing this agreement, the City of Duluth Parks and Recreation agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Minnesota Recreation and Parks Foundation from all claims arising from the grant sponsored program.
