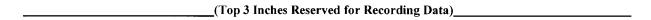

#### ACCESS EASEMENT AGREEMENT

This Access Easement Agreement ("Agreement") is made as of the \_\_day of \_\_\_\_, 2019 ("Effective Date"), by and between ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI, INC., D/B/A LAKELAND SHORES APARTMENTS, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation ("St. Francis"), and CITY OF DULUTH, a Minnesota municipal corporation (the "City") (sometimes collectively referred to herein as the "Parties").

#### **RECITALS**

- A. St. Francis is the owner of certain real property located in the City of Duluth, St. Louis County, Minnesota, and legally described in the attached <u>Exhibit A</u> (the "St. Francis Property");
- B. The City desires access over a portion of the St. Francis Property for pedestrian ingress and egress to Kelso Park, a public park dedicated in the plat of Kelso's Rearrangement of Blocks 1 and 2 of Sargent's Rearrangement of Blocks 16, 17 and 18, London Addition to Duluth ("Kelso Park") which easement is legally described on <a href="Exhibit B">Exhibit B</a> and depicted on the attached <a href="Exhibit Exhibit D">Exhibit B</a> and,
- C. St. Francis desires to grant such access to the City for the purposes set forth above and under the conditions and terms set forth below.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in and for consideration of the aforementioned Recitals, which are incorporated herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

l. Grant of Access Easement. Subject to any express conditions, limitations, or reservations contained herein, St. Francis hereby grants, declares, establishes, reserves, covenants, and dedicates to the City, in trust for the benefit of the public, an exclusive and perpetual easement over, upon and across that portion of the St. Francis Property legally described and set forth on the attached Exhibit B and as depicted on the attached Exhibit C (the "Easement Area") for the sole purpose of construction, maintenance, inspection, operation, protection, repair, replacement, and/or removal of a pedestrian walkway within the Easement Area for access to Kelso Park. To the extent that there is a discrepancy between the area described on Exhibit B and depicted on Exhibit C, the Easement Area shall be defined by the description on Exhibit B.

- 2. <u>Conditions of Access.</u> St. Francis shall not do or permit anything to be done on or to the Easement Area which may unreasonably impede, limit, or restrict pedestrian access to and from the public street known as North 45th Avenue East. All maintenance and repair work performed within the Easement Area with respect to the pedestrian walkway shall be performed by the City, at its sole expense.
- 3. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota.
- 4. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the Parties, whether written or oral. No modification or amendment of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by all the parties.
- 5. <u>Waiver</u>. No waiver of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed, or shall constitute, a waiver of any other provision, nor shall any waiver constitute a continuing waiver. No waiver shall be binding unless executed in writing by the party making the waiver.
- 6. <u>Authority</u>. Each party executing this Agreement hereby represents and warrants to the other that it has full authority and right to execute this Agreement.
- 7. <u>Counterpart Signatures</u>. This Agreement may be signed in counterpart, and the compilation of all executed pages will constitute a single, fully executed, original.
