Description

Twin Ports Rip Current Work Group (representing City of Duluth Parks and Fire Department staff, University of Minnesota Duluth – Sea Grant and Natural Resources Research Institute, the Coastal Program, YMCA/lifeguard, volunteer surf rescue, MN Department of Health, US Army Corps of Engineers, and Minnesota Point residents) exists to improve awareness of rip currents and reducing risk for people. The group talks about beach patrol, current needs, and related research.

The workgroup identified resources for the beaches at Park Point that both provide awareness and education (flagging, signage) and reduce risk by providing safety equipment for rescuers and bystanders. The City of Duluth (sub-recipient) has agreed to secure the necessary contracts to purchase, distribute/install, and maintain the acquired supplies. The supplies are portable or will be affixed to existing infrastructure.

The beach on Minnesota (Park) Point is city-owned parkland, and the City maintains the parking lots and rescue stations with assistance from the community and other partners, and under a contract with the YMCA. A map with the approximate locations is available on <u>Google maps</u>.

Task Outcomes

- 1. Purchase and distribute/install rip current safety equipment for Minnesota Point (Park Point) beach, this includes:
 - parkpointbeach.org billboard on Hwy 35
 - printed warning flags and flag signs at beach access locations
 - safety station signs
 - safety equipment
