Subject to the following easements and reservations:

- 1. Reservation by the City of easements for public pedestrian plaza purposes at and above the Superior Street elevation.
- 2. Reservation to the State of Minnesota in trust for the taxing districts concerned of minerals and mineral rights in those portions of the Site, the title to which may have at any time heretofore been forfeited to the State of Minnesota for nonpayment of general property taxes.
- 3. Any law, ordinance or government regulation including but not limited to building and zoning ordinances restricting, regulating or prohibiting the occupancy, use, enjoyment, improvement or subdivision of the Site.
- 4. The State of Minnesota shall retain a perpetual easement for the maintenance of, improvements to and reconstruction of the Lake Avenue Bridge as now located and established on and over the lands herein conveyed, above an elevation of 575 feet, elevation based on U.S.C. and G.S. 1929 mean sea level datum adjusted.
- 5. The State of Minnesota shall retain the right of reversion of the lands herein conveyed, should the Duluth City Council determine that the lands are no longer needed for public purposes by the City of Duluth.
- 6. No advertising devices of any form or size shall be permitted upon the lands herein conveyed.

No storage or manufacturing of any flammable, explosive, or hazardous materials or construction of any non-fireproof structure shall be permitted on the lands herein conveyed.

- 7. Any use or development of the lands herein conveyed for the parking of motor vehicles must be laid out to an orderly and functional design and must provide suitable fire lanes for the access of firefighting equipment and shall also provide for selective planting or other screening to maintain the aesthetic appearance of said lands; also any use for parking must include adequate bridge pier protection of the Lake Avenue Bridge.
- 8. The Grantee, as a part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree as a covenant running with the land for itself, its successors and assigns (a) that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination with regard to any facility located wholly or in part on, over or under such lands hereby conveyed; and (b) that the Grantee shall use the lands conveyed, in compliance with all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assigned programs of the Department of Transportation, effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and as said Regulations may be amended.
