To the Honorable The Mayor and the City Commissioners of The City of Duluth.

Gentlemen:

I am authorized by the purchaser and present owner thereof to offer to donate to the City of Duluth the Viking Boat "Leif Brikson". This is the historic boat that, in command of Captain Gerhard Folgero with his crew of three men, recently brought her into this port on their memorable voyage from Norway, following the course of Leif Brikson, who with a crew of thirty-five Vikings in Newfoundland and Nova Scotia and finally landed in Vintand, now Massachusetts, being the first known discovery by white men of this country.

This offer is made upon the following express conditions:

- 1) That the present LakesShore Park be officially renamed and maintained as "Leif Erikson Park";
- 2) That said boat, without its removal from the City of Duluth, be there permanently kept in such suitable enclosure or structure as will protect her from the ravage of the elements as well as damage or destruction, whether from fire or other causes:
- 3) That suitable provision be made and maintained whereby under proper regulations the boat may, during appropriate hours and in charge of some employee of the City, be open to the inspection of the general public;
- 4) That an appropriate tablet, with such other matters as you may designate, bearing her name, that of the captain and crew that sailed her from Norway into this port, as well as the name of the donor to the City, be placed upon the boat.

Upon these conditions and your acceptance thereof, the City will acquire and retain the absolute ownership of the "Leif Erikson".

In the event of a breach of any of these conditions the ownership and right of possession to immediately reverts to the present donor or such party as said donor may designate.

The name of the donor will be dischosed upon your acceptance of this offer.
