



FURTHER RESOLVED, that an interim use permit for the subject property, is approved subject to the following conditions:

- a) The applicant shall adhere to the terms and conditions listed in the interim use permit document and provide evidence of compliance, which will be included in the resolution to the City Council (guest record book including name, address, phone number and vehicle license plate; name, address, and phone number of local contact/managing agent to property owners within a 100 feet; rules of how the property can be used must be provided to guests including selected city ordinances on parking, parks, pets and noise; and acknowledge that interim use permit may be suspended in the event of multiple nuisance calls).
- b) The applicant must provide a written disclosure to all guests stating that quiet hours shall be observed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. in addition to other disclosures required by the Unified Development Chapter.
- c) The applicant will inform guests that the burning of trash in outdoor fire pits is prohibited.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution grants to ACW Duluth, LLC. an interim use permit for a six-bedroom vacation dwelling unit at 1615 East Superior Street. The interim use permit remains in effect for six years, or until the property changes hands, whichever occurs first.

The applicant has obtained an Operational Permit from the Fire Department and has applied for an inspection by the State Health Department for the property, in addition to a Lodging License before renting the property. The applicant has provided evidence of being set up to pay the appropriate taxes to the state and city. The applicant has paid for the required city license from the city clerk to rent short term.

On May 8, 2018, the city planning commission held a public hearing on the proposal and heard testimony from citizens. The planning commission voted 6 yeas, 0 nays, and 0 abstentions, with 0 commissioners absent, to recommend that the city council approve the interim use permit with conditions.
