FURTHER RESOLVED, that the mayor and clerk are hereby authorized to execute such documents as are necessary to implement the project on behalf of the city.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes application to the Minnesota Department of Transportation for a Transportation Alternative Program grant in the amount of \$384,091 to build a portion of segment 5 of the Campus Connector Trail. This segment was identified for improvement in the Campus Connector Trail Mini Master Plan. Recall that segment 2 of the trail was constructed adjacent to College Street in 2016. This project will be similar in that a portion of the road surface will be removed, new curb constructed, and a 10-foot shared use path installed.

The Transportation Alternative program is a reimbursable program, meaning recipients of the funds will front the costs of the projects, and then submit pay requests for reimbursement. Infrastructure projects chosen in this solicitation must be ready for construction during the 2026 construction season.
