RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH LHB, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE EAST NINTH STREET/EAST EIGHTH STREET RECONDITIONING PROJECT FOR AN INCREASE OF \$194,500 AND A NEW TOTAL CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED \$266,948.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to amend an agreement with LHB, Inc. for additional professional engineering services for the East Ninth Street/East Eighth Street reconditioning project for an increase of \$194,500 and a new total contract not to exceed of \$266,948, payable from 411-035-5530; PI2017-0855 (Permanent Improvement Fund; Capital Projects Accounts; Improvements Other than Buildings; 2017 Permanent Improvement Projects, 9th Street East/8th Street East Reconditioning).

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an increase to the agreement with LHB, Inc. for additional professional engineering services; including construction survey and layout and construction administration and inspection for the East Ninth Street/East Eighth Street reconditioning project from Sixth Avenue East to Woodland Avenue. The project involves milling of the existing pavement, placement of new bituminous, repair of catch basins, curb, gutter and sidewalks, and bringing pedestrian ramps up to ADA standards. This project is federally funded.
