

the St. Louis River for a range of audience interests and backgrounds. The 3.3-mile existing trail (formerly known as the Western Waterfront Trail) will be improved and the remaining seven miles will be built in seven segments. Proposed experiences draw attention to the history, wildlife, geography, and ecology of the river landscape that have made this an attractive destination for people and wildlife for millennia.

This request will fund construction of Segment 2 and 1000 feet of Segment 3- between Munger Landing and Blackmer Park and includes trail, trailhead and park amenity improvements to Munger Landing and Blackmer Park, including interpretive elements, signage and wayfinding.

A 1:1 match is required. The City has applied for match funds up to \$2,000,000 from the Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources (LCCMR) and up to \$286,800 from the Minnesota Historical Society, as authorized by Resolutions 21-0181R and 21-0526R, respectively.
