



and trails: Spirit Mountain Recreation Area, the Duluth Traverse, and Hartley Park. Programming must take place primarily on these parks and trails.

Programming will take place during summer and after school. City staff will meet youth serving agencies by appointment at an agreed upon trailhead. A qualified instructor will teach basic bike skills, trail etiquette, and safety rules as well as more advanced skills as youth progress. Lessons and equipment will be age appropriate.

Grant funds will pay for purchase, maintenance, replacement, and transportation of a fleet of mountain bikes and other program costs. The City of Duluth will provide a matching contribution by proceeding with the previously approved purchase of a Parks and Recreation programming vehicle that is included in the current Capital Equipment Program budget.
