

moor and embark and disembark passengers. The conceptual design attached as Exhibit B has been presented to the community, stakeholders, and the Parks and Recreation Commission.

The paired seawall and plaza projects are part of the coastal infrastructure rehabilitation project approved for \$13.5 million of state bonding support in the 2020 legislative session under the heading, "Duluth Seawall and Surface Improvements." The estimated \$19,753,010 seawall and waterfront plaza project will be paid for with \$13.5 million of state bonding support, \$2.6 million of federal support, and \$3.6 million of local government investment.

The complete plan for reconstruction of the DECC seawall and plaza, as well as portions of the Lakewalk and Brighton Beach, will be presented to a City Council Committee of the Whole in February.
