## CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, pursuant to the authority of Law of Minnesota, 1997, Chapter 231, Article 2, Section 53 the Duluth city council hereby determines to reassess the below-referenced properties for assessments previously canceled by reason of tax forfeiture.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution confirms the City's intention to reassess the prior canceled assessments against the properties for the collection of solid waste. The properties have now been purchased through St. Louis County's Land Department.

Under the statute referenced above the City Council has the discretion to reassess properties for the amount of the canceled assessments. A public hearing was held by the Special Assessments Board on October 8, 2019 and their recommendation is to reassess the parcels for the original assessment amount, removing all
