RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE TO VARIOUS LICENSEES.

### CITY PROPOSAL:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the city council of the city of Duluth hereby approves issuance of the following temporary liquor licenses, subject to departmental approvals, with any further restrictions, and further subject to approval of the liquor control commissioner:

Duluth Superior Pride (Duluth Superior Pride Festival) - Application for a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license for September 3, 2022 at Bayfront Festival Park, 350 Harbor Drive.

GND Development Alliance (Brews and Boards) - Application for a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license for June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Lake Superior Railroad Museum, 506 West Michigan Street.

Ronald McDonald House Charities (Brew Love North 2022) - Application for a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license for August 11, 2022 at the Greysolon Ballroom, 231 East Superior Street.

Duluth Airshow Wings Foundation (Duluth Oktoberfest) - Application for a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license for September 16-18, 2022 at Bayfront Festival Park, 350 Harbor Drive.

Duluth Airshow Wings Foundation (Duluth Airshow) - Application for a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license for July 16-17, 2022 at the Duluth International Airport, 4701 Grinden Drive.
