SUBJECT/TITLE: RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A “NO PARKING” ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST COLLEGE STREET FROM 19TH AVENUE E TO LAWN STREET.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

Resolution No. 23-0600R authorized an agreement with Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. for engineering services for the Campus Connector Segments 4 and 5 and College Street reconstruction project for an amount not to exceed \$426,105.

Resolution No. 24-0989R established “no parking” zones on the north side of West College Street from Junction Avenue to Woodland Avenue, on both sides of West St. Marie Street from Carver Avenue to Woodland Avenue, and on both sides of East St. Marie Street from Woodland Avenue to Vermilion Road for this project as well as several zones for the 2025 Junction Avenue and St. Marie Street project.

Resolution No. 25-0696R amended the original contract (L30860) with Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. for the Campus Connector Segments 4 and 5 and College Street reconstruction project to increase the amount by \$162,000.00 for a new total of \$588,105.00.

BACKGROUND: This resolution codifies and extends the existing “no parking” zones on College Street. The proposed roadway does not meet MnDOT State Aid requirements for roadway width unless parking is prohibited on both sides of the road. In order to utilize MnDOT State Aid funding for the roadway project a resolution prohibiting parking is required. No residents are affected by this change, as the houses do not have frontage on this section of West College Street.
