BACKGROUND:

This concurrent use permit allows for the installation of a new wireless microsite to a new pole in the right of way for Parkwood Lane.

On April 14, 2026, the Duluth city planning commission held a public hearing on the proposal as described in Attachment 2 and voted 3 yeas, 0 nays, 1 abstentions, to recommend that the city council approve the request for a concurrent use of streets.

Having reviewed and considered the application and conducted a public hearing, the planning commission recommends that the city council approve the concurrent use permit with the conditions stated.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: The applicant will be responsible for installation and maintenance of the pole and infrastructure. No fiscal impacts to City budgets are anticipated.
