**SUBJECT/TITLE:** RESOLUTION AMENDING AND CORRECTING THE TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,204,823 TO THE CORRECT TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,307,676.00 IN RESOLUTION 24-0305 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SOFTWARE LICENSING, MIGRATION SERVICES, VPN APPLIANCES AND ANNUAL SAAS HOSTING FEES FOR THE CITY'S MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (RMS) FROM TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** Resolution 24-0305R approved the contract; however, the total 5-year amount was incorrect.

**BACKGROUND:** The City has utilized Tyler Technologies for Police Records Management (RMS) since 2020. In 2024 it was resolved to move to Tyler Cloud to integrate with the St. Louis County (SLC) Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system as the County had selected the Tyler Cloud Hosted CAD system. This migration and merger allows the City of Duluth to host all SLC police agencies in the City's RMS. The contract was approved by council in 24-0305R; however, the math was incorrectly totaled to \$1,204,823.00 and should have been \$2,307,675.00 as the site license and maintenance was missed in the total presented for years 2-5. The partner agencies are contributing the correct amount ensuring budget for the full amount.
