SUBJECT/TITLE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF LINCOLN PARK DRIVE FROM JUST EAST OF THE MILLER CREEK BRIDGE AT 7TH STREET AND JUST WEST OF THE 10TH STREET BRIDGE OVERPASS TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: In November of 2011, City Council approved resolution 11-0626 which authorized seasonal closure of Lincoln Park Drive from Fifth Street to 10th Street.

BACKGROUND: This resolution authorizes the permanent closure of the upper end of Lincoln Park Drive to vehicular traffic. Neighborhood stakeholders and City staff support the closure of this segment of Lincoln Park Drive. This segment of Lincoln Park Drive has been on the “seasonal” closure list of streets that are not plowed in the winter. This resolution would allow for the prohibition of vehicle traffic on this portion of Lincoln Park drive permanently. The closure will allow for enhanced pedestrian and bicycle use of the existing roadbed. A similar recommendation to close this portion of Lincoln Park Drive was included in the 2016 Lincoln Park Mini Master Plan, adopted by City Council in 2026. The Plan intended “...to better accommodate bike and pedestrian use and contribute towards establishing a more looped trail system within the park.”
