PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

September 22, 2025: Council approved a detour agreement with MnDOT. November 13, 2023: Council approved the State Project within Municipal Limits (Municipal Consent).

BACKGROUND: This resolution will authorize City Officials to enter into a cooperative agreement with MnDOT for the London Road project. The City is responsible for our share of the cost for our local city street legs of the roundabouts, the crosswalk flasher systems just east of 32nd Ave. East and 60th Ave. East, rail crossing improvements, and the City's share of requested utility work. The agreement also commits the City to snow removal and maintenance of the sidewalk and our legs of the roundabouts. Although the rail crossing costs are included in the estimate, a separate agreement for the rail work will be presented to council in the future.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: Use Federal, Municipal State aid and appropriate utility funding that is in the 2026 proposed budget.

OPTIONS: Approve or deny the agreement.
