BACKGROUND: This cooperative agreement allows the City to participate in cost sharing offered by St. Louis County to perform long line road striping painting in the City of Duluth. Street Maintenance has successfully participated in this program for the past 4 years. This program offers road striping services at lower cost to the county and multiple municipalities in the summer construction season. By participating in this project Street Maintenance can reduce expenses and focus maintenance efforts on other core City services that may otherwise have gone uncompleted.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: This project is planned for 2027 and is part of the projected budget for that year.

OPTIONS: **Approve** and the road line striping for safety will be performed at a reduced cost to the City. Do not approve and the work will need to be performed at a higher cost and the City risks falling behind on core street maintenance projects.
