PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: 22-0389R passed on 05/09/22 sponsoring infrastructure development grant for up to \$12.85 million.

23-0296R passed on 04/24/23 sponsoring infrastructure development grant for \$13,492,500.

24-0299R passed on 04/22/24 sponsoring infrastructure development grant for up to \$16,817,100.

BACKGROUND: Hallet Dock 7 needs refurbishment and this is the opportunity to apply for federal funding.

BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT: If Hallett Dock No. 7 is awarded grant funding, the city will be the sponsor, which means the city will let the project for construction, be responsible for payments and reimbursement from the Federal Government. Per the MOU, the city would recover all expenses for administration of the project. The city will be fully reimbursed by the grantor and Hallett Dock No. 7 for the match to the federal funds and administrative costs.
