**SUBJECT/TITLE:** RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO K&H EXCAVATING INC. FOR THE CHAMBERSBURG AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$434,234.00.

**BACKGROUND:** This resolution will authorize City Officials to enter into a contract with K&H Excavating Inc. for the replacement of water main on Chambersburg Avenue north of Anderson Road. The existing water main has a long history of repairs and was originally constructed during a historically poor era of pipe. This project timeline is critical because the roadway is also scheduled to be re-paved in 2026 with the City wide Street Improvement Project. The project will be utilizing pipe bursting technologies as determined to be the most cost effective means of replacement.

The project is planned to be constructed in two phases, splitting the project at the Miller Creek crossing. The project duration is anticipated to last 8 to 10 weeks.

**BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT:** This resolution is for a contract in the amount of \$434,234.00, payable from Water Utility Fund 510, Department 1905 (Capital Projects Accounts), Object 5533 (Improvements Other than Buildings), City Project no. 2306. Adequate budget was allocated for this project, despite the Engineer's Estimate being 30% less.
