**BACKGROUND:** The Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant supports specialized training for firefighters to safely respond to incidents involving hazardous substances, such as gas leaks or chemical spills. This funding helps ensure our personnel maintain the necessary skills and certifications, while also reducing training costs for the city. We have received this grant for multiple years, providing consistent financial relief to the department's training budget.

**BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT:** This resolution authorizes the allocation of a \$5,200.00 grant to offset training expenses, reducing the need for local budget funds to support firefighter hazardous materials preparedness.
